This is to inform you that P. Oyebolu of Boys' High
Ibadan
School/will be admitted as a Provincial Scholar
to this College in January, 1946.

2. All boys must be at the College on and not before January 16th
1947.

3. All boys should bring with them:

- ✓ 2 blankets
- ✓ 1 pillow
- 2 pillow cases
- ✓ 1 box
- ✓ 1 sleeping cloth
- ✓ 1 new white half-sleeved singlet
- ✓ 1 fork
- ✓ 1 spoon
- ✓ 1 drinking cup or glass.
- ✓ 1 mosquito net

4. Boys are expected to provide their own native dress for
wearing in the evenings.

5. Fees. (a) Tuition. Fee-payers pay £12 a year for tuition.
These fees are payable termly (there are 3 terms in the year) in
advance, i.e. £4 per term payable in January, April and September.
Fee-payers whose fees have not been paid before the beginning
of a term will not be admitted to the class-rooms.

6. Method of Payment.

- (a) Tuition fees may be paid into a Local Treasury and the
Treasury Receipt forwarded to the Principal. If tuition
fees are sent direct to the Principal, a Treasury Receipt
will be forwarded by the Principal.

Deposit. Both Fee-payers and Scholars pay £5 a year for books
clothes and games materials. A minimum of £3 must be paid
before the beginning of the 1st. term in January and the
balance not later than June 30th. All boys who do not
complete payment of the Deposit in time will not be
issued with books or clothes.

- (b) The Deposit must be paid in cash, by Postal Order or by
Money Order direct to the Principal who will forward an
official receipt. In no circumstances should the Deposit
be paid into the Treasury.

7. Minimum Fees payable before admission is granted in January.

Fee-payers. £4 tuition + £3 Deposit = £7.
Scholars. £3 deposit.
